Special Operations Warrior Foundation (SOWF) provides full educations and additional educational opportunities, "cradle to career" (preschool – college), for the surviving children of Special Operations Forces (Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marine Corps) lost in the line of duty as well as children of all Medal of Honor Recipients. SOWF also provides immediate financial assistance to severely wounded, ill, and injured Special Operations Personnel — today and in the future.

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES INCLUDE:

- College tuition, room & board, and miscellaneous college expenses.
 Incoming freshmen receive a laptop and printer package.
- Preschool programs for children ages 2 5 (up to \$8,000 per year)
- Private school tuition assistance (up to \$5,000 per student, per year, kindergarten -through 12th grade)
- Educational programs specifically designed for students with disabilities
- Unlimited private tutoring for students of all ages (kindergarten through college graduation)
- High school summer academic, leadership, and professional programs
- Access to online tools for ACT/SAT test preparation
- College planning conference (Operation E.P.I.C.) hosted by SOWF for high school students
- Access to online college planning platform, College Success Academy
- College to Career transition program, including funds available for internship relocation and an opportunity to study abroad

EXPANDED ELIGIBILITY:

Expanded eligibility to include active-duty Special Operations
Personnel who have lost a spouse – this recognizes the critical role
spouses play in the lives of our families. These children will now
receive the same benefits as all other children in SOWF's
educational programs.

JUNE 24-25, 2023

Over the weekend of Saturday, June 24 and Sunday, June 25, 2023, the fourth annual long-range shooting competition, Heart Mountain Challenge, will be held on the iconic and historic Heart Mountain, north of Cody, Wyoming, on over four square miles of private, mountainous and scenic land.

Approximately 100 of the country's top marksmen, a combination of former and current Special Operators (Army, Navy, Air Force and Marine Corps), military members and civilians, will gather to compete in a variety of assorted difficult timed target shooting, with selected target distances up to 2,000 yards away, at elevations of over 7,000 feet.

The two-day competition will feature two separate shooting areas. Shooters will be divided into two groups, swapping shooting areas on day two.

On Sunday evening, the 25th, an awards dinner will be held, where participants will have the opportunity to network and discuss the weekend's activities, and also learn more about SOWF in an entertaining setting.
